

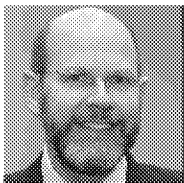

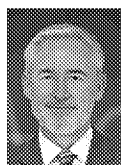


Chairman – Jason Marshall: Executive VP, Transmission and Regulatory Affairs at Wabash Valley Power (Indianapolis)
