Week In Review



This week's [energy headlines](#) include new provincial spending on energy ads, a new Ontario Energy Association (OEA) energy poll, and the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) rules on energy rates.

CTV News reports the Ontario government is earmarking \$5.5 million to advertise cuts to hydro bills. The ads are meant to promote the Fair Hydro Plan, introducing 25% off residential hydro bills.

In response to a freedom of information request by the New Democrats, government documents cite "negative media coverage" of rising electricity costs as a key piece of context for why the advertising campaign is needed.

On Monday, the OEA released its annual energy polling conducted by Innovative Research Group. The poll finds that if a provincial election were held today, 40% of decided voters would vote for the Progressive Conservatives, 35% for the Liberals, 18% for the NDP and 5% for the Green Party. 46% of voters have a negative impression of the Fair Hydro Plan, while 19% think about it positively.

In a media release, the OEB issued a decision regarding Hydro One's 2017/2018 Transmission Revenue Requirement and Rate Settlement application. Capital spending is approved at \$950 million for 2017 and \$1 billion for 2018. New rates are effective January 1, 2017.
