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Week In Review



This week's [energy headlines](#) include Toronto's mayor speaks out about hydro executive salaries, Chalk River hearings begin, and a wind farm shuts down turbines after a turbine collapse incident.

Toronto Mayor John Tory told the *Toronto Sun* that he wants a cap on salaries for new hires at Toronto Hydro's executive management. He has asked staff to report on a possible upper limit for compensation across the broader municipal public sector, not just Toronto Hydro.

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission opened the first of three days of public hearings Tuesday on whether to approve a 10-year operating licence renewal to Canadian Nuclear Laboratories, the consortium running Chalk River Labs, according to the *Ottawa Citizen*. If approved, the licence would stretch until 2028, a period of extreme change, starting with the decommissioning of the NRU reactor April 1.

CBC News reported Monday TerraForm Power has shut down all 51 of its wind turbines as a precaution due to an incident where one of its wind turbines collapsed. An investigation has been opened. The Ministry of Labour and the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change are also investigating.

In other news, the Ontario PC Party Leader [Patrick Brown](#) has resigned and the party is considering next steps with respect to choosing a new leader. The Globe's [Marcus Gee](#) reflects on the conclusion of the legal proceedings with respect to the gas plants scandal and [Parker Gallant](#)
