Good evening,

As discussed at the end of our meeting this afternoon, IESO needs to be prepared to brief the new government by July 2018 with a set of materials that explain existing IESO initiatives, related issues and policy options that the new government may consider.

Leading up to the development of the briefing materials, there will be a discussion with the IESO board at the April strategy session on key topics, considerations, potential opportunities and risks from IESO's perspective. To support this discussion, we're seeking your input on the key topics outlined in the attached document. For each topic, we'd ask that you review the identified considerations (e.g. varying courses of action) and identify the potential impacts from your perspective.

While your input is welcome on any topic, the document identifies individuals who may have particular interest in certain topics. I'll set up time to speak with these individuals directly in the next few days. I'd also ask that you please send me your written responses (including ballpark quantification of impacts where applicable) by Friday March 23.

As I mentioned this afternoon, this initiative also provides an opportunity to communicate the following roles/responsibilities within Policy, Engagement and Innovation with regards to policy-related work:

- Innovation, Research & Development (IRD): develops policy recommendations where needed by IESO, seeking input from across the organization and outside as needed to formulate options and broker recommendations
- Corporate & Indigenous Relations (CIR): facilitates input to policy options from outside the organization through engagement activities and determines the approach to advance policy recommendations with the appropriate stakeholders, including government
- Regulatory Affairs: provides a regulatory perspective and facilitates input from the OEB, as appropriate
