All – a takeaway from the Minister's meeting yesterday with OCC, the attached includes the results of a survey of OCC members on their awareness and perceptions of electricity related matters (billing, conservation programs, GA). This provides some insights to consider as the IESO develops its OCC outreach efforts.

Also, these are some of the themes from the discussion today:

- Storage and encouraging research
- System costs
- ICI - Conservation allows for avoided costs of new generation, eligibility at threshold can result in higher rate/costs if conservation brings the consumer below threshold)
- SaveONEnergy Retrofit Programs
- Climate change and use of funds under cap and trade - use for investment in non-emitting resources or carbon reduction projects vs. general revenues
- Distribution reliability - Balancing need to invest to maintain/enhance distribution-side reliability (costs) with rate increases tied to inflation under FHP
