I'm sure Terry and team have been all over this, but I thought I'd share with the broader team given the recent swings in the polls. It might be thought provoking as we speculate on the go-forward options for IESO and how an NDP biased majority/minority Government might look at the sector.

A few of the main themes that jumped out for me;

1. Re-establish **independent, transparent, public oversight of Hydro One (Hydro would be 100% public owned)**, including from the Auditor General, Financial Accountability Officer, Information and Privacy Commissioner, Ombudsman, Integrity Commissioner and French Language Services Commissioner;
2. Establish an **expert advisory panel** tasked with providing advice for the responsible, expedient return of Hydro One to public ownership and control.
3. Removal of mandatory TOU billing
