Further to our discussion today,

Seasonal class is a live proceeding right now and the panel is deciding on timelines for implementation as part of the decision.

However, what I can tell you is that the Regulation for triple-R P (link below) defines residential premises as:

“a dwelling occupied as a residence continuously for at least eight months of the year and, where the residential premises is located on a farm, includes other farm premises associated with the residential electricity meter;”

So a second residence does not qualify for triple-R P. Only a primary residence.
