Hi George –

Below are numbers for Windsor and Sarnia.

Note that Windsor is served by EnWin Utilities Ltd; Sarnia is served by Bluewater Power Distribution Corp. Numbers reported by each distributor for the service area for which they are licensed are shown in the table.

The distributor service area may not be the same as the region (for example, the region may well include Hydro One customers but we do not have any breakdowns by region. Hydro One reporting is for the whole service area for which it is licensed, not for specific regions.

Sylvia –

The numbers of customers reported as of the third quarter of 2016 are shown in the table below. A couple of comments:

I assume that all customers eligible for RPP would be eligible for the 25% savings – this would include total customers in both the residential and GS < 50kW distribution rate classes, and the number of customers on RPP in the GS >= 50kW distribution rate class.

However, with respect to the customers in this latter rate class that have contracts with a retailer (i.e., the numbers highlighted in yellow in the table), one cannot assume that all of these would be eligible for RPP if they were not with a retailer. Our reporting requirements do not ask for this breakdown, so caution is suggested if the highlighted numbers are to be used.
