Applications

- OPG. Biggest rate application in Canadian history and staff filed a submission that was very well received by the industry.
- This past year also saw a number of first vintage application types: examples, community expansion and cap and trade compliance plans on the gas side. Lots of good work by staff to develop novel approaches to these applications.
- 22 community meetings in the 2017 calendar year with more to come in Jan/Feb. Lots of good work by Sylvia's team, our case managers and our presenters (Kristi, the various lawyers on the files, Jennifer, Jane, Dan).

Policy

- Approved five Regulated Price Plan pilots targeting more than 20,000 customers across 10 service areas
- Developed the Strategic Blueprint to guide the OEB's priorities over the next five years in order to keep pace with a changing sector.
- Implemented a suite of changes to RPP prices and other affected rates to reflect the Fair Hydro Plan
- Spearheaded the preparation of an implementation plan, still in development, to respond to the Government's Long Term Energy Plan

Public Affairs

- Launch of the website.
- Extending the consumer panel to include an online component of 2000 consumers and creating a stand alone small business panel.
- Made our first foray into community engagement with a booth at the Ex, the Royal Winter Fair and a number of Seniors events.
