No Change to Electricity Prices November 1st

The OEB will announce today that there will be no change to the prices for time-of-use (TOU) and tiered rate customers on November 1st. These are the prices that apply to most households and small businesses.

While the OEB is holding the line on TOU prices until at least April 30, 2017, we will remind consumers that on-peak times are changing and they can realize savings by adjusting their conservation habits accordingly. Winter TOU hours, shown in the chart below, come into effect on November 1. For customers who still pay tiered RPP prices, the Tier 1 threshold increases from 600 kWh to 1,000 kWh. The threshold for small businesses stays at 750 kWh/month all year.

The current prices and new time periods are:

Category	New Times – Winter (Nov 1-Apr 30)	Price	Change
Off-peak	Weekdays 7pm-7am All day weekends and holidays	8.7 ¢/kWh	No Change
Mid-peak	Weekdays 11am-5pm	13.2 ¢/kWh	No Change
On-Peak	Weekdays 7-11am and 5-7pm	18.0 ¢/kWh	No Change

The OEB reviews electricity prices twice each year based on updated cost forecasts and they are designed to recover the actual cost of electricity.
