Independent MPP Jack MacLaren's legislation Bill 197, Affordable Electricity Act, which calls for the repeal of elements in the Fair Hydro Act, was granted second reading. In an unusual move, Acting Speaker Ann Hoggarth passed the bill "on division" without holding a recorded vote, despite protestations from MPPs. This was preceded by MacLaren being kicked out of the House for accusing the government of "breaking the law" with its Fair Hydro Plan.
