Great meeting. One more media outlet (radio AM 680) shortly after I sent the earlier email, for a total of five outlets - a record.

Lots of good questions and statements from consumers, one of whom was particularly eloquent.

Key issues - conservation is not fair as consumers get charged more to cover system/utility's cost, reliability issues in certain parts of Essex (why do we have to pay for service we are not getting), time-of-use for seniors esp (a few mentioned they were getting up at 5am to do laundry to avoid mid-and-peak), several consumers said they voted no for the rate increase due to numerous outages/lack of service and lack of affordability. One consumer mentioned she and her husband were choosing between medication and the electricity bill. A few commented on Fair Hydro Plan announced this morning saying they know it means taking the money out of the other pocket or delaying paying the cost.

The five media outlets stayed for the whole meeting so should get some good coverage.
