A new Angus Reid poll shows 82 per cent of Ontarians continue to oppose the Hydro One sell off and 74 per cent consider their household hydro bills “unreasonable.”

Meanwhile, sixty-two per cent of Ontarians said Premier Wynne’s plan to refinance hydro debt will play an important factor in who they vote for in the next election. Data analysts said Wynne’s plan has “captured the attention of Ontarians,” meaning voters could respond positively if it successful in lowering their household bills, but will also be ready to punish her if the promised discounts do not materialize.
