Liberal Party leader, Wynne was in Owen Sound Saturday to speak at the nomination meeting for Bruce—Grey—Owen Sound Liberal candidate Francesca Dobbyn. She will run for the Liberals in Bruce—Grey Owen Sound.

The Globe and Mail featured an in-depth look at the accounting discrepancy between Premier Kathleen Wynne's Fair Hydro Plan and Auditor General Bonnie Lysyk.
