

A. How Much of the Bill does the OEB regulate?

- Taking all of its rate-setting activities into account, the OEB's rate regulation covers about half of the costs that make up a typical customer's bill, prior to considering the impact of any credits or bill reduction measures such as the Fair Hydro Plan.
- This reflects our rate setting for all Ontario distributors, transmitters, and setting payments for nearly all of OPG's electricity production.

IF PRESSED

- We regulate the prices paid to OPG for its nuclear output and nearly all of its hydroelectric generation. This represents about 30% of the total annual cost of electricity supply (ie, generation), and a little less than 20% of the bill currently.
- We set rates for all of Ontario's 69 distributors – (about 20% of the bill)
- We approve the revenue requirements of Ontario's transmitters, and set the uniform transmission rate for the whole province (less than 10% of the bill)
- We also set loss factors and regulatory charges (5% of the bill or less)
