Also, I have extensively presided as a member and team leader in Divisional Court. This is a specialty court which deals with appeals from both Masters and Judges of the Superior Court and exercises a supervisory jurisdiction by way of judicial review over most of the administrative boards in Ontario. As an ad hoc judge of the Ontario Court of Appeal I have participated in appeals from decisions of the Review Board. Finally, I have served as the Regional Senior Judge for Toronto from 2007 - 2013. As the supervising judge over 90 judges of the Toronto region I was tasked with total responsibility for administering the region and with exercising the delegated powers of the Chief Justice in assigning work to each judge of the region.
