Dear Doug Downey, Attorney General, Ontario and Elizabeth Dowdewsell, Lieutenant Governor, Ontario

I am a Toronto, Ontario, born and raised, educated professional. I have a health and science doctorate. I have reached out on numerous occasions, via email and by phone, to Premier Doug Ford.

I have asked for the science and documentation that was used to justify the Covid measures. I received only a standard, pathetic email response, in return. I reached out again, and provided my own scientific documentation, that did not support further lockdowns, since they have been based on faulty PCR tests. We live in the northern hemisphere and are subject to what is called "winter burden." Colds and flus thrive from about November until April.

The majority of Ontario's casualties from Covid were sadly in long term care facilities. We learned just how neglected some of our seniors were, in some of these places.

In the spring, when deaths were no longer being reported, *the numbers reported switched from deaths to 'cases.'* People lined up for sometimes hours at a time, to get a test, to find out if they were positive. This is beyond ludicrous. **When is the last time that you had to line up, to be told that you were sick?**

When masks were mandated in Toronto on July 7th (when the curve was beyond flattened), **there were only 120 Covid related patients in approximately 400 Ontario hospitals!! One patient for every 3 hospitals!** There is no evidence for masking healthy people, but there is evidence that it can cause harm.

Bill 218 that has been proposed is in no way beneficial for the majority of men and women of this province. It is called Supporting Ontario's Recovery and Municipal Elections Act??!!

If you actually want to support Ontario's recovery, then this is what needs to be done:

- Open up all businesses now! We are ALL essential.
- Stop using faulty tests to drive up the numbers, to 'justify' the lockdown.
- Listen to the seniors (my husband's 91 year old aunt is one of them) who would rather risk getting Covid, than live the rest of their days, not being able to see and hug their families.
- Consider the real damage that is being done to our kids. They cannot play with their friends, even though there is NOT ONE death of anyone in Canada under 19 (compared to 10 deaths from the flu in the same age group, the year before). They are forced to sit all day at school in a mask and learn from a masked teacher. They are not receiving vital facial cues with their communication. There is no mention of their innate, intelligent immune system. Instead, they are treated as dirty vectors of disease.

- Take a hard look at the increase in mental health issues, increased overdoses and suicides. A lot of this is due to the imposed lockdowns, when NOT one province met the qualifications to declare a State of Emergency!

What absolutely canNOT happen is to allow those, who have been involved in implementing these Covid measures, to be immune from accountability. They need to be held personally responsible for ALL their decisions and ALL their actions.

We have a democratic process for a reason, and it was, on a few different occasions, okay for Mr. Ford to NOT have open debate in Parliament, to NOT have a transparent voting process, and therefore, if he is going to make these decisions unilaterally, then he can be held responsible for these same decisions and actions, unilaterally as well.

This week, a judge ruled against the unjustified restrictions that Governor Newsome inflicted upon the people of California. We expect the same to occur here in Ontario.

Mr. Ford, Mr. Tory and Mr. Trudeau (and many others) will be having their day in the public court system soon enough, and *ALL* those who have assisted in these wrong-doings will *also* be held accountable.
