I was shocked by news of revoking Traditional Chinese Medicine Act 2006 and moving TCM and Acupuncture into public domain. This action will be a huge threat to public health and safety.

Like other healthcare practitioners, TCM Practitioners and Acupuncturists must receive about 3000 hours comprehensive academic study with 500 hours supervised clinic training at least to provide the quality of care to public.
