I was shocked by news of revoking Traditional Chinese Medicine Act 2006 and moving TCM and Acupuncture into public domain. This action will be a huge threat to public health and safety.

Like other healthcare practitioners, TCM Practitioners and Acupuncturists must receive about 3000

hours comprehensive academic study with 500 hours supervised clinic training at least to provide the quality of care to public.

Revoking the TCM Act 2006 means putting the public health and safety under the risk from those unskilled or qualified “therapists”.

I would like request that you take a serious consideration and please remove Schedule 5 from Bill 88, 2022 for the goodness and wellbeing of all Ontarians. (
