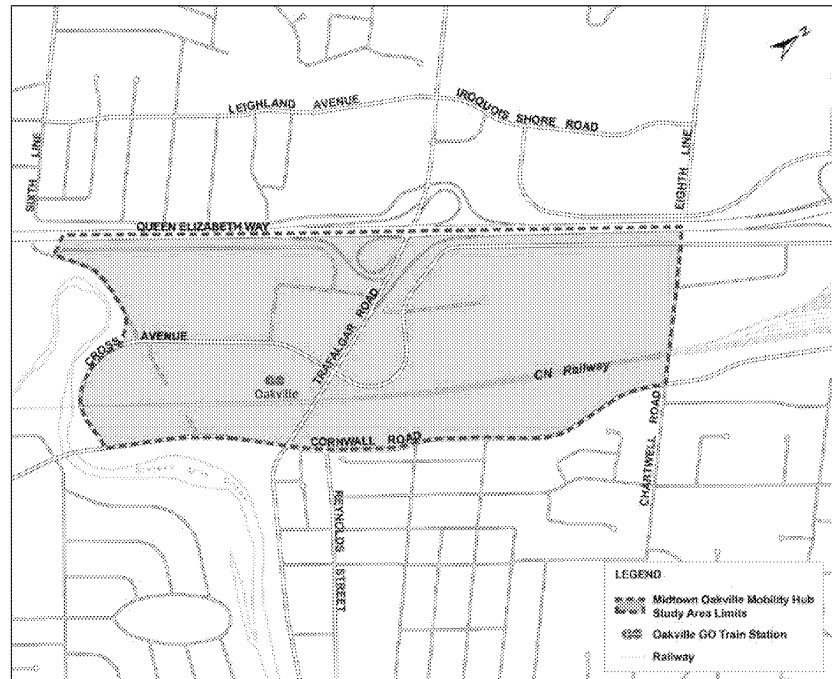


PUBLIC WORKSHOP

MIDTOWN OAKVILLE MOBILITY HUB STUDY TOWN OF OAKVILLE

Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, is helping transform the way our region moves by championing and delivering mobility solutions for the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA). As we invest in the future and build stronger transit infrastructure to meet the growing needs of the region, a number of projects are underway. GO service continues to be expanded and improved to provide more choices for travel across the GTHA, meet increasing customer demand and attract more transit users in the future.

THE PROJECT

Metrolinx is seeking your input on the Midtown Oakville Mobility Hub Study. The Big Move, Metrolinx's Regional Transportation Plan, identifies 51 mobility hubs throughout the GTHA. Mobility hubs consist of major transit stations and the surrounding area (about an 800-metre radius around the station). The Midtown Oakville Mobility Hub Study Area has the same boundary as the Midtown Oakville Urban Growth Centre, which was defined by the Province, in consultation with the Town.

Mobility hubs serve a critical function in the regional transportation system as the origin, destination or transfer point for a significant portion of trips. They are places of connectivity where different modes of transportation – from walking to biking to riding transit – come together seamlessly and where there is an intensive concentration of working, living, shopping and/or playing.

You are invited to attend our workshop to find out more about the study and to provide input into the preliminary design concepts proposed for the area. Metrolinx and Town of Oakville staff will be on hand to answer questions and receive your comments.
