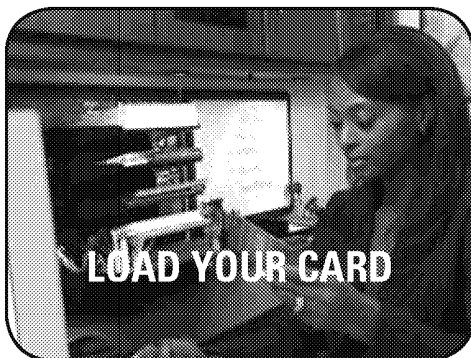
AUDIO:

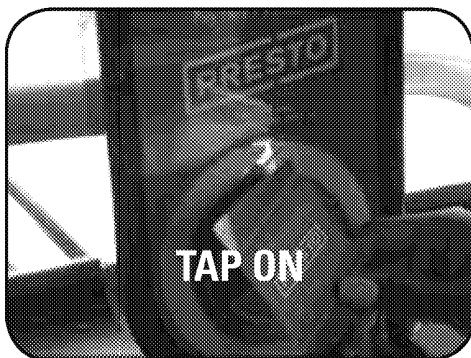


Step 2 – Load your card at PrestoCard.ca, over the phone, or at a PRESTO customer service outlet.

Step 3 – Tap your card onto a PRESTO reader when boarding, and you are automatically deducted the lowest possible amount from your remaining balance.

PRESTO also acts as your transfer. Tap your card when switching buses, trains or routes and the system will know you're transferring.

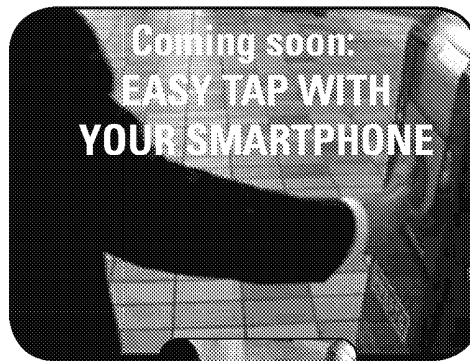
