INSTALLATION OF A CENTRALIZED RAILWAY SIGNAL SYSTEM AT DOWNSVIEW AIRPORT CITY OF TORONTO

Metrolinx, an agency of the Province of Ontario, is helping transform the way our region moves by championing and delivering mobility solutions for the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA). As we invest in the future and build stronger transit infrastructure to meet the growing needs of the region, a number of projects are underway including many involving our GO Transit division. GO service continues to be expanded and improved to provide more choices for travel across the GTHA, meet increasing customer demand and attract more transit users in the future.

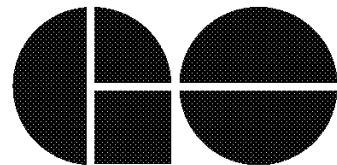
A new railway signal system will be installed along the GO rail corridor between Toronto and the City of Barrie to enhance system safety and improve service levels. It will carry voice and data transmissions between the rail corridor and GO Transit's Rail Traffic Controllers.

To accommodate the new railway signal system, the existing 15-metre radio tower beside the level crossing at Carl Hall Road will be replaced with a 30.5-metre railway communication tower.
