Hi Dina,

Here is the storyboard for the panels.

I am sending you this but will call you to discuss as well. Everything is placement. Font etc. will all change.

What we still need are bigger images. The images are 200 dpi but they are not for 4 feet panels. When we actually place them on the panels they are only about 10 inches big - which won't work.

We need the images to be as big as possible. 200 dpi works but it has to work for 4 feet.

Here's a breakdown of what we would need:

Panel 1: Sets up the issue

- since we don't have the vectors for the maps, we can outline them ourselves
- but we will also have to outline the little dots; they won't be dots so much as an outline of congestion - is this okay?

Panel 2: Introduces Metrolinx and tells visitors there is a plan to get us out of this gridlock

- is there an image that you have that would be suitable for this

Panel 3: Big Move title and mission statement

- we'd like to use the image that is on the cover of the brochure on the website
- the image with the people and transit out of focus

Panel 4: Breakdown of what the Big Move is

- we'd like to use the image that looks like you are traveling, more inspirational type image

Panel 5: Nine Big Moves

- we will create icons for each one of these sentences since the images from the ppt are all different styles it won't look cohesive

Panel 5: Projects under way

- we'd like to use the Word Cloud

Panel 7: Benefits of Investment
