Hi Phil. Yes I would use data for April 2015 to July 2015, that shows there will be five (5) consists in revenue service made up of two (2) DMU's per consist. After July, it's now a little more complicated. As you know, Rail Equipment & Assets had indicated that operating with only six (6) consists (5 in revenue service and 1 in the shop) would compromise their ability to meet the maintenance requirements, both by regulation and preventative maintenance requirements.

To maintain 15 minute headways and meet maintenance requirements, it was agreed that we would operate with 7 consists (5 in revenue service and 2 in the shop) consisting of four (4) three (3) car consists and three (3) two (2) car consists. Based on the equipment cycling, on some days we would have any combination, that would have five (5) consists in revenue service.
