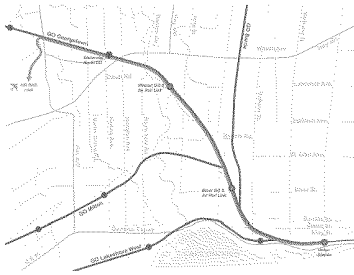

The Airport Rail Link (the ARL) offers a direct rail connection between Pearson Airport and downtown Toronto Union Station, with stops at Bloor and Weston GO stations. It will commence operations in 2015.



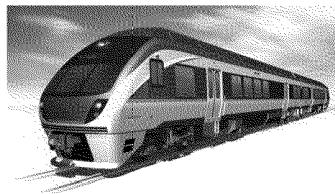
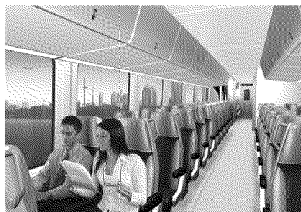
At Pearson Airport, the ARL will connect directly with Terminal 1, and will provide an easy connection to the Airport People Mover, which services the Pearson remote parking lots and Terminal 3. At Union Station, a new platform will be built specifically for the ARL. The line will have 4 stations: Union Station, Bloor GO station, Weston GO station, Toronto Pearson International Airport.

It is anticipated that the ARL will operate every 15 minutes between 5am and 2am, seven days a week, and travel time between the airport and downtown will be approximately 25-30 minutes.

The service will be a premium high-speed, state-of-the-art service with plush interior, special luggage capacity, onboard monitors displaying flight information on trips to Pearson and information about Toronto sites on the trip to Union.

The terminal stations at Union and Pearson will have comfortable lounges, which will have an open, modern feel. The terminal at Pearson will have centralized multi-language passenger information and platform edge doors for safety.

Other planned services and amenities include: On-board customer attendant, lounge attendants, PRESTO (Electronic Farecard), linkage of ticketing with airlines.
