I have the honour to submit herewith the Twenty-Ninth Report of The Liquor Control Board of Ontario for the twelve months fiscal period which ended the 31st of March 1955.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT

On the Balance Sheet appears the usual certification by the Auditors of the Board, Messrs. Dick, Bond, Hetherington & O'Loane, Chartered Accountants. The amount of fixed assets of \$506,587.25 represents the value, less depreciation of \$11,810,580.68 of the Board's real estate, together with all furniture, fixtures, machinery and equipment in the stores, warehouses and offices. The real estate consists of lands and buildings situated at 55 Fleet Street East, Toronto; land and warehouse at 210 Victoria Avenue, Fort William; and land and store building at 28 Silver Street, Cobalt. The warehouse premises formerly occupied by the Board at 125 Fleet Street East, Toronto, were transferred to Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario as represented by the Honourable the Minister of Public Works during January 1955.

The Confiscated Stock item represents a balance due for forfeited liquor which was purchased by the Board after analytical examination and in accordance with the provisions of Section 116(2) of The Act. The Transfer Fees liability constitutes amounts deposited as Transfer fees with the Board by sundry licencees whose trans-

fer of ownership had not been approved by The Liquor Licence Board as of March 31, 1955.

The Reserve Accounts previously created for insurance of \$1,000,000.00 and for contingencies of \$1,500,000.00 remained as at the close of the previous year-end.

After all the Board's transactions had been recorded, a Surplus was shown of \$22,835,640.00. Conforming with the procedure of last year, an appropriation for the financing of merchandise inventories, fixed assets, etc. was thereupon provided to the extent of \$17,418,468.78. Therefore, as it appears on the Balance Sheet and brought forward from the Surplus Account, the resulting difference as being available for transfer to the Provincial Treasurer was \$5,417,171.22.

Contingent liabilities amounted to \$13,474,945.28. These items represent the value of undelivered orders to an extent of \$9,983,885.17 and also the amount of \$3,491,060.11 for Customs and Excise Duties which are payable on the goods which were in bond in the warehouse on March 31, 1955.

These contingent liabilities have no reflection on the trading profits of the Board.

The Profit and Loss Account shows sales for the 12 months of spirits, wines and beer from Liquor Control Board stores of \$118,145,617.25.

The same account shows a gross trading profit of \$44,742,225.56 with total expenses including depreciation of \$11,298,560.44 which resulted in a net trading profit of \$33,443,665.12. The amount shown as other revenue of \$13,015,356.63 was derived from permit sales, fees, taxes on brewers and wine manufacturers and their products, from licence holders' fees and from fines. The net income carried forward to the Surplus Account is \$46,459,021.75. The expenses incurred by The Liquor Licence Board amounted to \$528,814.66 are included in the total expense amount.

For comparative purposes, the percentage that the cost of stock sold, miscellaneous earnings and expenses and other revenue bear to the sales are given for the fiscal year 1953-1954 and the 12 months' period herewith reported upon.

The amount shown on the Surplus Account as being brought forward from March 31, 1954 represents the accumulated surplus from previous years' operations not transferred to The Provincial Treasurer of \$22,626,737.42, less an appropriation for the purchase of merchandise, etc. of \$15,450,196.70. Therefore, to this balance of \$7,176,540.72 is added an adjustment for the current year's appropriation of \$1,968,272.08, as well as the net income for the year of \$46,459,021.75. From this figure a sundry adjustment of \$119.17, cost of land at 125 Fleet Street East, Toronto, of \$250,000.00; and payments to the Provincial Treasurer of \$46,000,000.00 are deducted to arrive at the amount which is carried forward to the Balance Sheet as an unappropriated surplus of \$5,417,171.22.

A statement showing the expenses of administration and operation for the twelve months is also attached. Individual percentages in comparison to the total sales are given for the 12 months and also for the preceding fiscal period. On March 31, 1955, the staff of The Liquor Control Board and The Liquor Licence Board numbered 1744 employees, 133 of these being part-time or seasonally employed, compared with 1677 permanent and 114 part-time at the previous year-end.

All Liquor Control Board stores, brewers' retail stores, breweries and wineries from which alcoholic beverages are sold in Ontario as of March 31, 1955 are listed on Schedule I and a classification of permits and licences issued appears on Schedule II.

SALES

The sale of spirits, beer and wine from liquor stores during the 12 months amounted to \$118,145,617.25. The net value of beer sold from breweries and brewers' retail stores, exclusive of any charge for containers, totalled \$135,387,706.00. Sales of Canadian Wine made direct to customers from licensed Ontario wine sales offices and, where permitted, from winery premises, amounted to \$5,210,227.14.

Sales of spirits, wine and imported beers from Liquor Control Board stores to licencees operating under The Liquor Licence Act amounted to \$6,728,108.45 and are included in the previously-mentioned total liquor store sales figures.

As shown previously in this report, the Board paid to the Provincial Treasurer the sum of \$46,000,000.00 on account of profits, licence fees, etc. The Board also created a liability for payments to the various municipalities of a proportion of the fees received from licencees, such amount totalling \$838,497.82 which was distributed to 246 municipalities.

Additional to the above payments made by the Board, the Dominion Government received \$38,188,642.28 during the course of the year in Customs and Excise duties and \$6,438,121.72 for sales tax on spirits, wines and imported beers purchased by the Board.

The Dominion Government also received approximately \$45,000,000.00 for malt duties and taxes on domestic beers and wines sold in Ontario, the total aggregating \$89,000,000.00.

Therefore, the grand total of revenue payments received by the respective Dominion, Provincial and Municipal Governments was \$136,000,000.00 as a result of levies on alcoholic beverages sold in Ontario during the year. This amount was exclusive of Dominion and Provincial Corporation and Municipal Realty taxes paid by the respective manufacturers and licence holders.

All brands of beer produced by the Ontario breweries and by the Quebec breweries which are sold in this Province were periodically analysed, as in the past, thus ensuring that beer sold in Ontario is in conformity with the Regulations passed pursuant to The Food and Drugs Act of Canada.

The Board receives from its laboratory at the Toronto Warehouse current analytical reports of all brands of spirits, wine and beer.

WINERIES

The number of wineries operating in the Province was reduced to 12 during the twelve months' period, the licence of one being transferred upon its purchase by another winery.

HOME-MADE WINE PERMITS

Regulations which became effective January 1, 1940 require that any person manufacturing more than 100 gallons of home-made wine must obtain a permit from the Board. Five were issued during the year ending March 31, 1955.

PERMITS

941,683 individual annual liquor permits were issued for the year ending March 31, 1955. Individual permits sold to non-residents, valid for a period not exceeding one month, numbered 110,987. In addition, 1,389 special permits were issued to physicians, druggists, hospitals, etc.

551 special permits were issued to druggists during the year, their purpose being to allow druggists to purchase limited quantities of spirits for compounding medicine or for use as a solvent or preservative. They were also permitted to buy rubbing alcohol for resale.
